## Primary Registration 2018-2019

We are currently preparing for the next academic year. If you have a child who was born before December 31, 2018, they are eligible to start school in Sept 2018. We ask that you phone the school as soon as possible with name address and DOB so that we can get them pre-registered. Public Health, dental hygienist, classroom teacher and others will then have you travel through the "stations" allowing us to collect the information necessary to provide your child with a safe and easy transition to school. 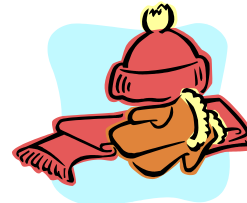
